
Do not use abrasive cleaning products.

Preventative Measures:



Do not put any extremely hot or cold food items/beverages in direct contact with the wood surface as this may cause marking or damage to the finish. Spills must be cleaned immediately or this may cause discoloration to the wood and may cause permanent damage.

Shrinking, Cracking, Warping:


Keeping the humidity at an even level throughout the year will prolong the life of your table. Wood is very susceptible to changes in the humidity of its environment, which causes it to expand and shrink. Climate control will minimize this. A level of 40%-55% humidity with an ideal temperature of 70-72 degrees Fahrenheit should be maintained.

Solana Triangular End Table





ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

KEEP ALL PACKAGING MATERIALS UNTIL YOU HAVE VERIFIED ALL COMPONENTS AND PARTS.

1. Gently rest the tabletop onto a clean, flat surface.
2. Align the notches and join the sets of legs together to form the table base.
3. Secure the tabletop and table base together with the four screws provided.
4. Gently flip the table right side up.


